MONDAY, MAY 25




WEDNESDAY, MAY 27 (BREAKFAST, LUNCH)

THURSDAY, MAY 28 (BREAKFAST, LUNCH)

We begin another exciting day with a beautiful drive southward on the Seward Highway as we make our way to the Seavey "Ididaride" Complex. Members of the Seavey family won six consecutive Iditarod races (2012 -2017) and eight overall. We'll be treated to a wilderness dogsled ride! Feel the raw power, enthusiasm and energy of the amazing Iditarod sled dogs as they pull your comfortable wheeled sled along a two-mile trek through the Alaskan wilderness to the base of Resurrection Mountain and along Box Canyon Creek. Afterward, your Iditarod veteran guide will tell you exciting stories about their Iditarod experiences and take you on a tour of their facilities, including the kennel area where you'll be able to cuddle adorable puppies. Next, we're on our way to board Celebrity Cruise's beautiful Summit for a 7-night cruise. Get settled in your fabulous stateroom and explore the ship before we sail away at 8:00 p.m.


