Afterward, your Iditarod veteran guide will tell you exciting stories about their Iditarod experiences and take you on a **tour of their facilities**, including the kennel area where you'll be able to cuddle adorable puppies. Next, we're on our way to board **Celebrity Cruise's** beautiful **Summit** for a 7-night cruise. Icy Strait Point is the port for adventure.
